Local access will be maintained

Emergency access will be maintained

Detour routes will be posted

Mt. Pleasant Road will be reduced to one lane during working hours. Traffic will be controlled by temporary automated traffic signals. Access to properties will always be maintained except when work is occurring in the immediate area of the driveway. The contractor will provide 24hrs notice of any driveway disruptions.

Burtch Road will be closed to all traffic in the immediate working area during working hours. Detour signage will be posted along Pleasant Ridge Road, Ellis Avenue and Mt. Pleasant Road. Access to properties, including the Mt. Pleasant Park will always be maintained except when work is occurring in the immediate area of the driveway/park entrance. The contractor will provide 24hrs notice of any driveway/entrance disruptions.

County of Brant and Contractor staff will be available in-person at the Pavilion at Mt. Pleasant Park between 4:00PM and 6:00PM on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 to meet with local residents and answer any project related questions.
